#RunForHope is a project of the AfriForum Trauma Unit that is aimed at creating awareness about farm murders and farm attacks in South Africa.

The funds are used to support victims of this atrocity by, inter alia, cleaning up scenes of farm attacks, material support, assistance with medical expenses, trauma counselling for victims as well as their loved ones, and also advice by experts about investigation and court procedures.

The professional athlete Johardt van Heerden, in cooperation with the AfriForum Trauma Unit, will be hosting the next #RunForHope race on 28 October 2023 from 07:00 to 12:00 at Vredenheim wine estate in Stellenbosch.

Van Heerden is an excellent athlete who has completed some of South Africa's toughest routes. He has represented South Africa several times at national level and has completed the Otter hiking trail, known as one of the toughest routes in South Africa, five times and won it four times.

Johardt, who lives in Durbanville in Cape Town's northern suburbs, is giving his all for trauma victims. "It is sad to see that many people are losing hope because of the challenges South Africans are facing. The challenges, including farm murders and farm attacks, are enormous, but we can still choose how we are going to react to them," Van Heerden says.
